HISTORIC HOUSE MARKERS



The marker is a cast bronze oval plaque, which is sturdy, weather-resistant, of quality casting and with an attractive, elegant design compatible with the architectural styles of the Cambridge Historic District. The markers include the actual (EST.) or approximate (CIRCA) year of construction. The size of the plaque is 11 inches wide by 8 inches high. The markers have a life expectancy of approximately 20 years, with little maintenance required except for a clear coat of lacquer every few years. When ordering, specify front or rear mounting. Plaques for front mounting include 2 pre-drilled holes and brass screws. Rear mounting requires ¼-inch studs and adhesive (not supplied). Recommendations for placement will also be provided, to encourage uniformity.

The display of an Historic Marker will demonstrate community pride in our beautiful historic buildings and the unique architecture to be found in our Historic District.

The current cost of each plaque is \$280. (Price increase expected in June 2017)
A 25% deposit is required, balance upon delivery. Delivery averages 8-10 weeks from order date.
